
MEDICAL Respiratory illness



- Problematic in large animal shelters due to high volume of dogs and cats entering and leaving daily
- Viral illness can progress rapidly
- Impact at ACC
 - 3,875 dogs received
 - 2,827 dogs placed
 - 43 confirmed Pneumonia
 - 27 New Hope
 - 16 Adoptions
