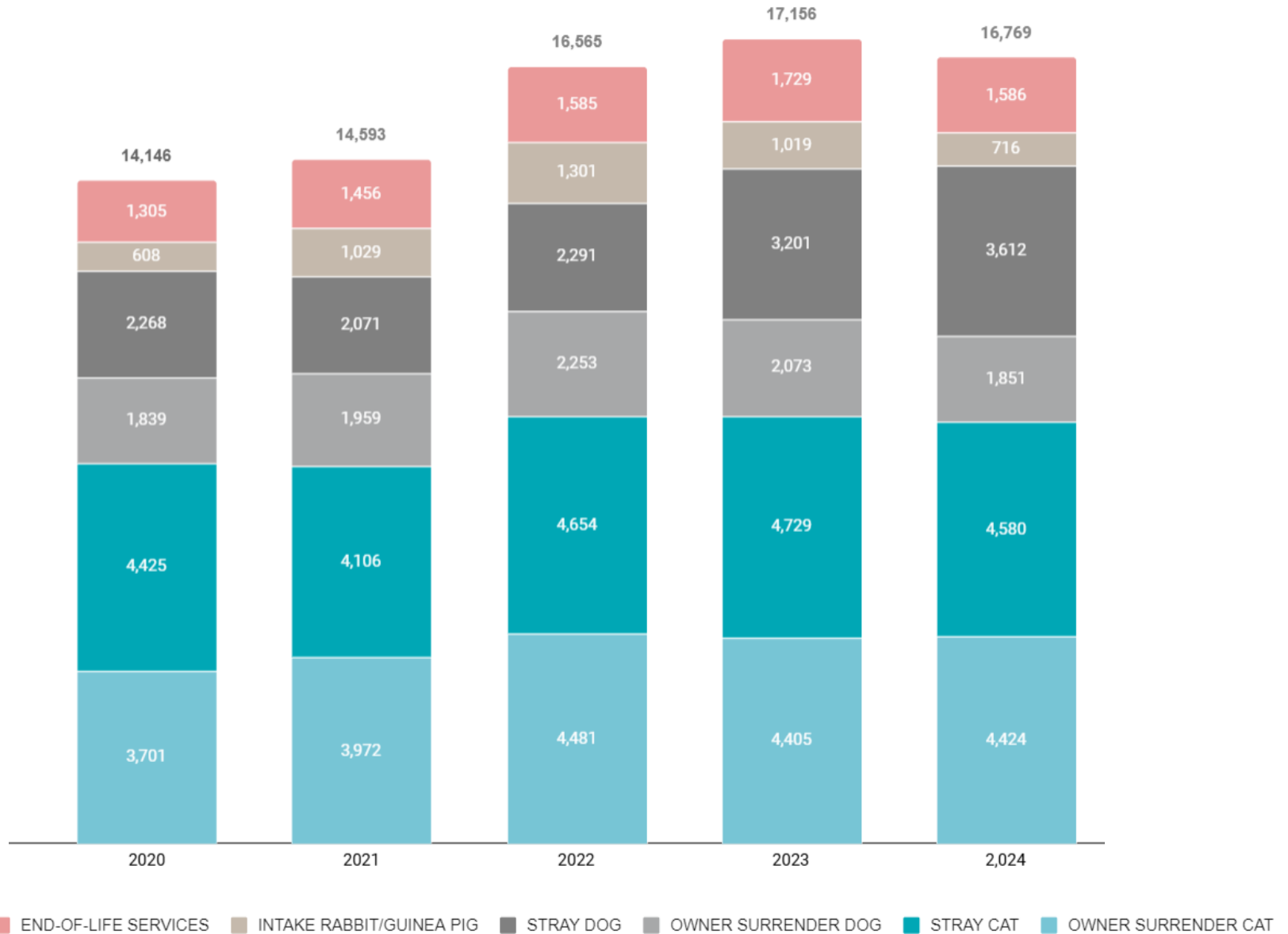

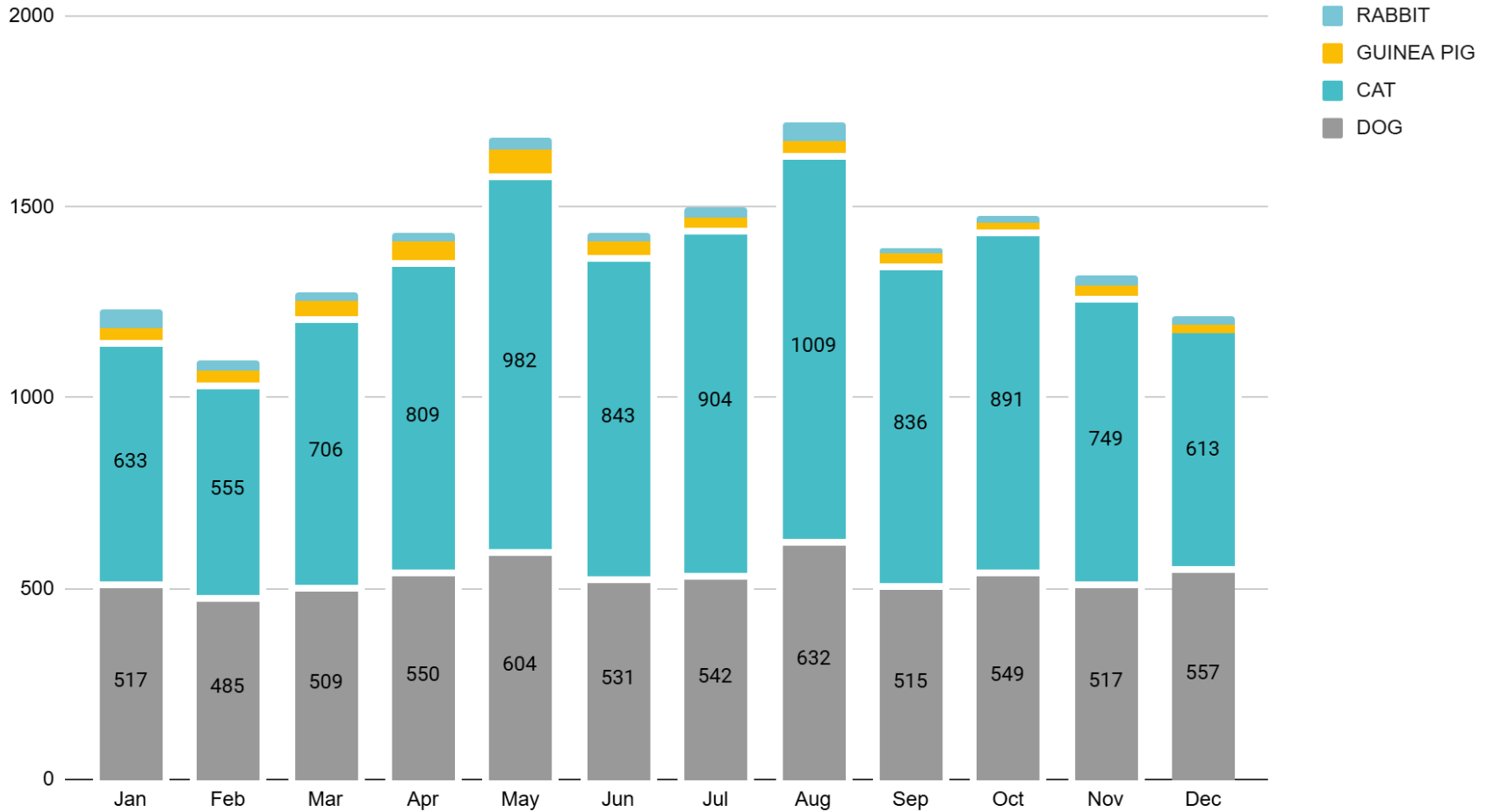

INTAKE BY MONTH

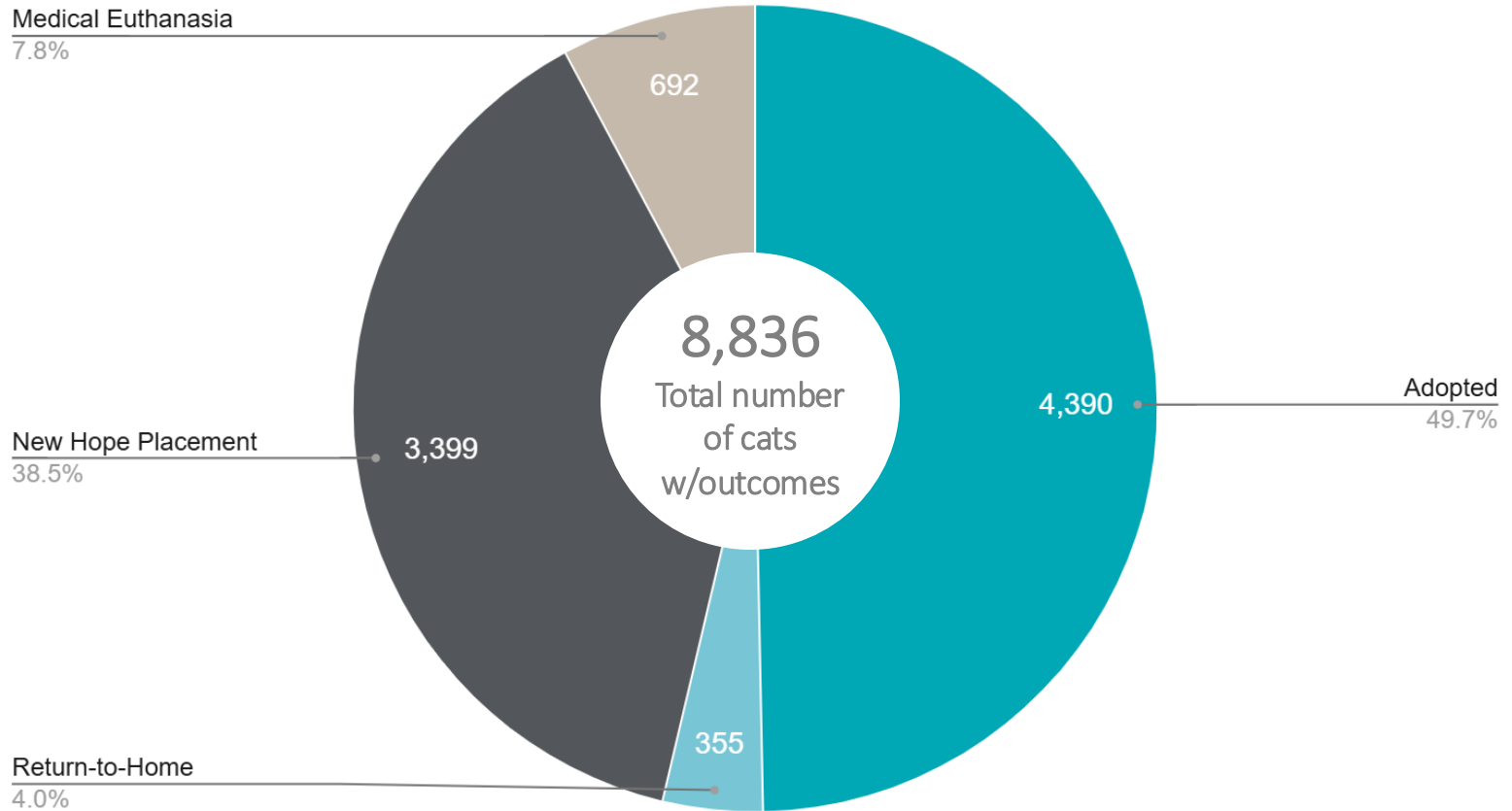
2024 Monthly Intake by Species

Cats 92.2% (90.9% 2023)

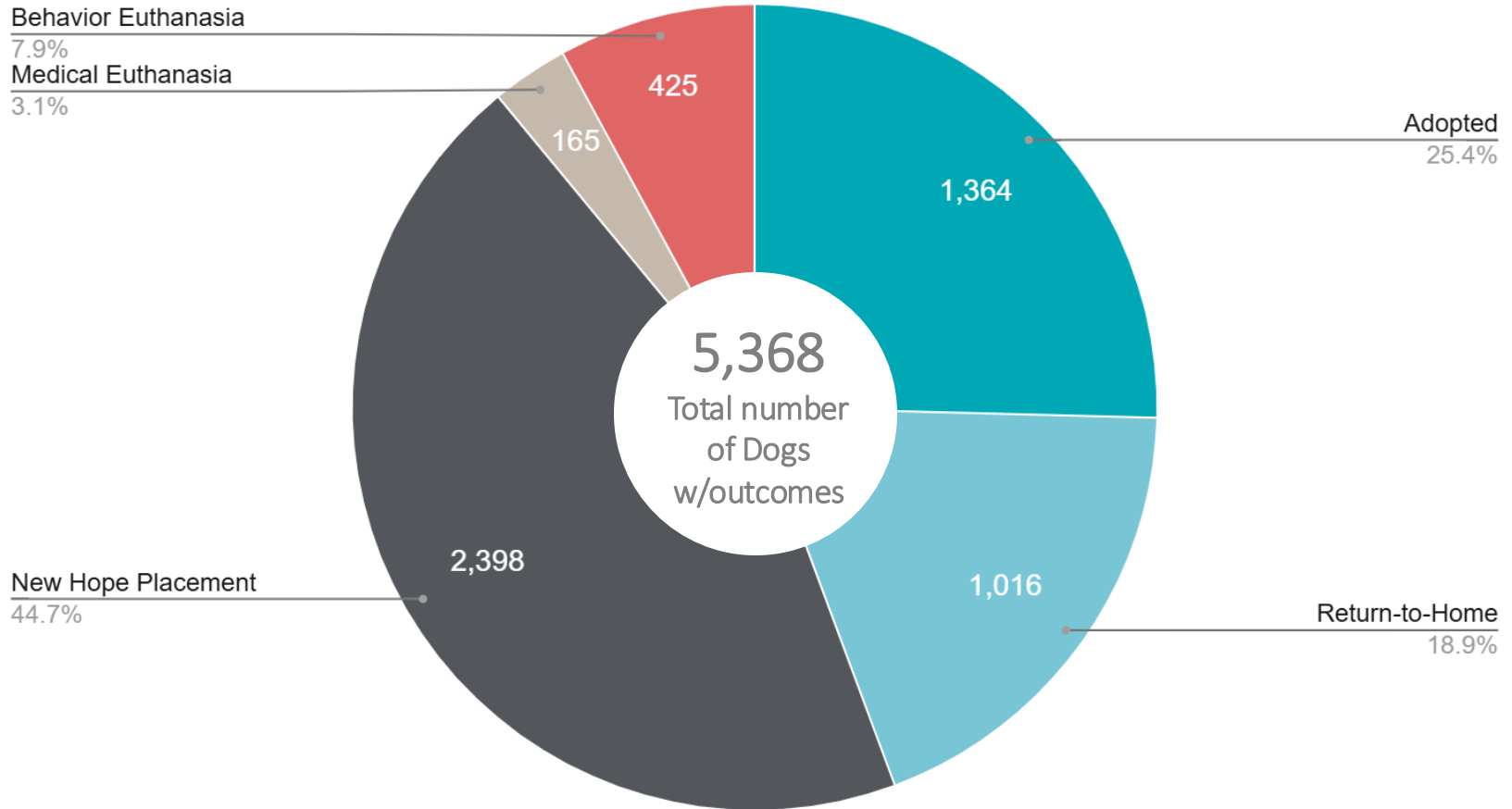

Dogs 89.0% (89.0% 2023)

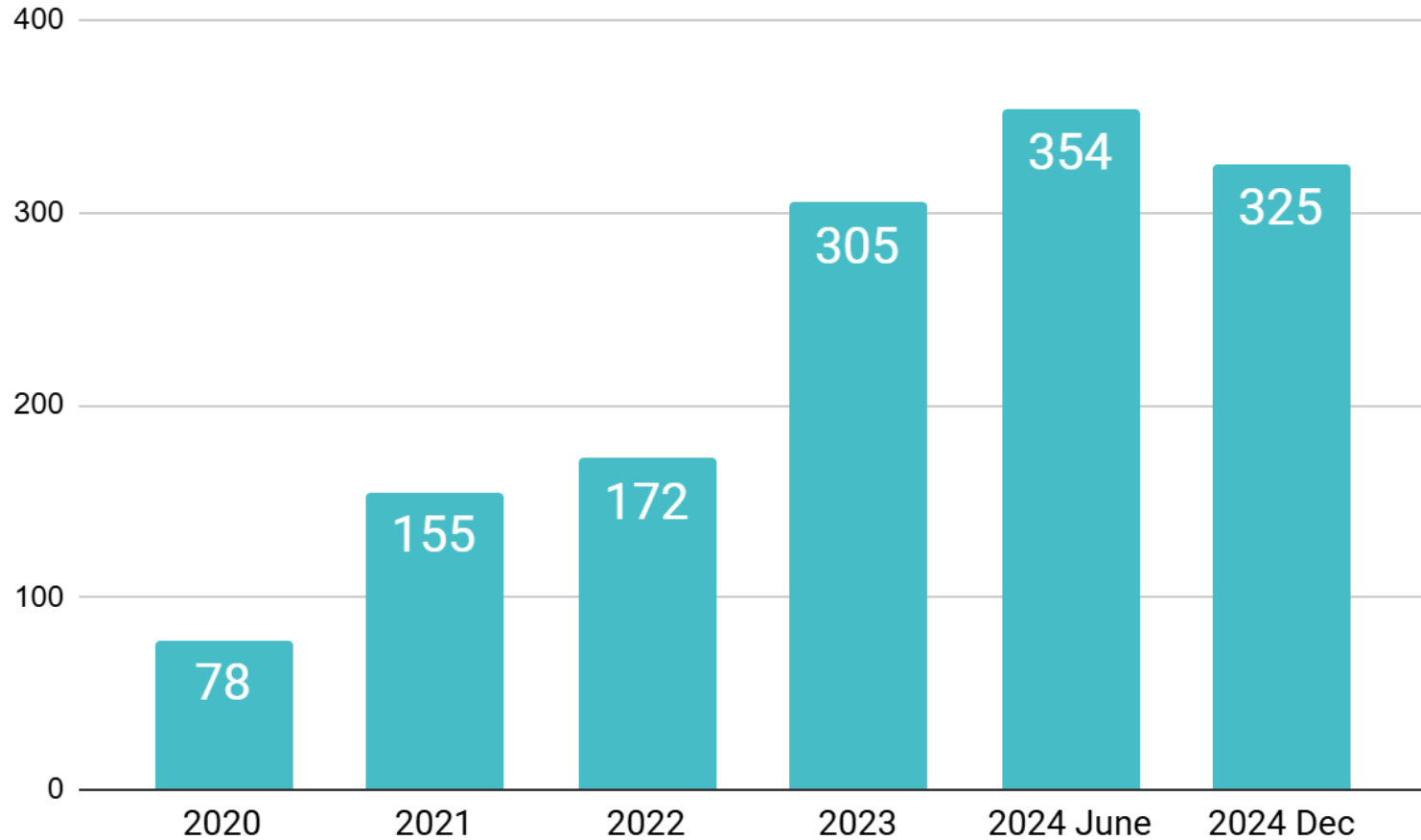

DAILY POPULATION PRESSURES

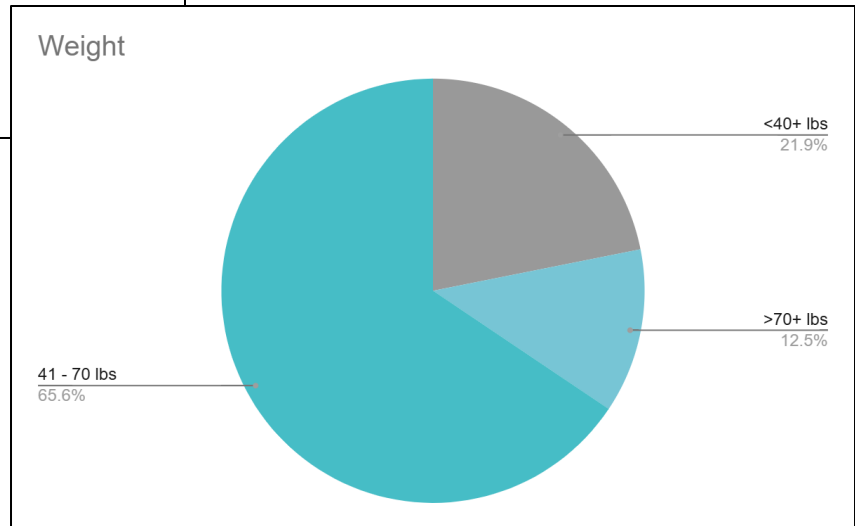
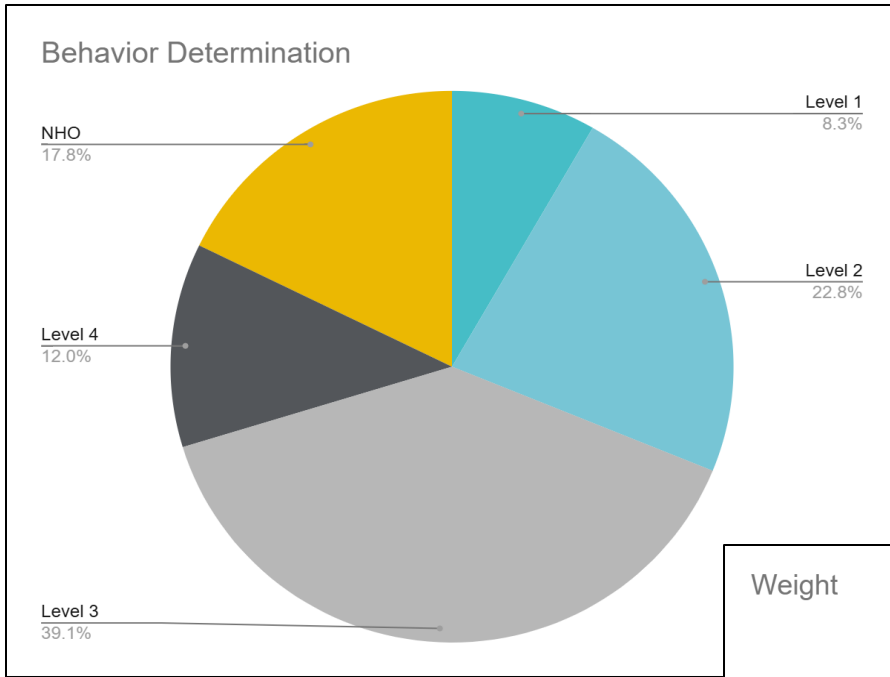
Average Dog Population

Demographics of Dogs in Shelter





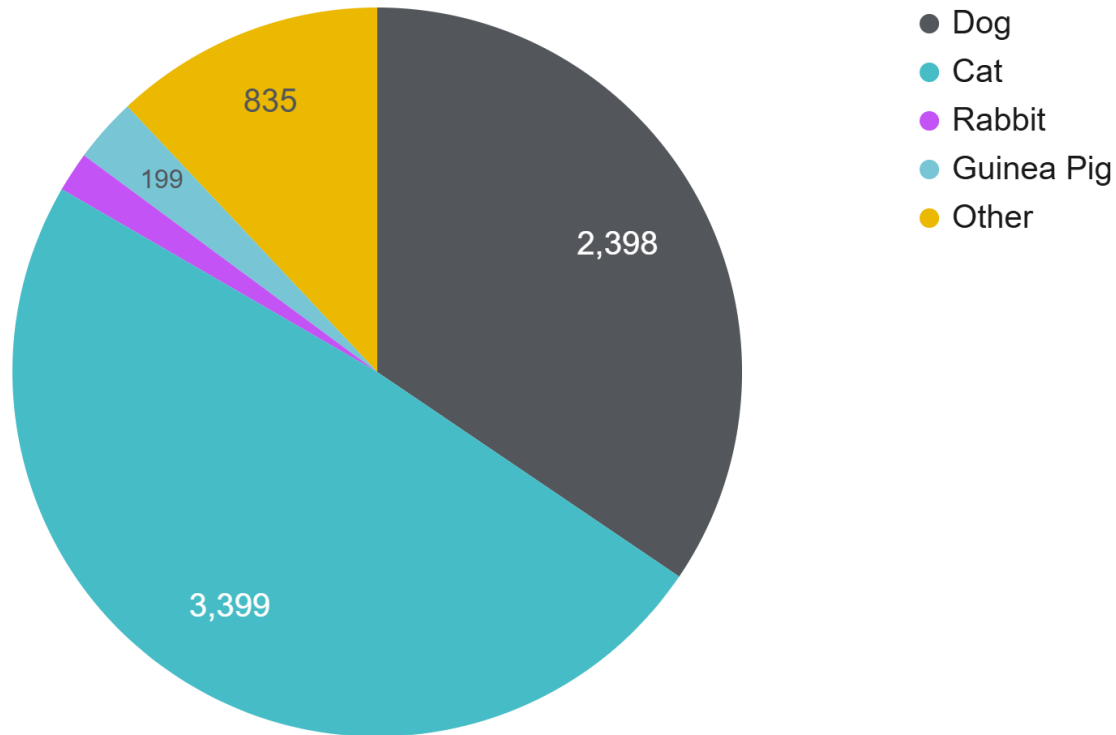

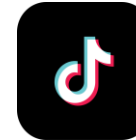
