The ASPCA Animal Hospital is a low-cost or free emergency animal hospital located at 424 E 92nd Street New York, NY. The ASPCA Animal Hospital provides urgent care exclusively for animals whose owners' total annual household income is \$50,000 or less and whose pet has a qualifying medical condition. However, meeting this income requirement does not guarantee financial assistance. If you'd like to apply for financial assistance, please bring one of the following items with you: EBT CARD (Benefits card), SSI Award Letter, VA Benefits Letter, Proof of Unemployment or Workers' Compensation, or Proof of TANF benefits (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families).

Hours: By appointment only Monday through Saturday, no walk-ins accepted. Closed on major holidays.

You must call at 7 AM in the morning for a same-day appointment. The ASPCA only books same-day appointments, and their appointments are typically full by 8 AM due to the high volume of callers that they get.

The ASPCA also operates three Community Veterinary Clinics in New York City, which offer free or low-cost vaccine and wellness services, such as physical examinations, vaccines, in-house diagnostics and medications, by appointment only for eligible dog and cat owners.

Eligibility is as follows for each location:

- Long Island City, Queens: The ASPCA Community Veterinary Clinic by The Rachael Ray Foundation™, located at 36-02 14th St., Long Island City, NY, 11106, is available to pet owners with proof of public assistance* living in one of the following zip codes 11101, 11102, 11103, 11104, 11105, 11106, 11368, 11369, 11370, 11372, 11373 and 11377
- East New York, Brooklyn: The ASPCA Community Veterinary Clinic by the Alex and Elisabeth Lewyt

 Charitable Trust, located at 464 New Lots Ave., Brooklyn, NY, 11207, is available to pet owners with proof
 of public assistance* living in one of the following zip codes 11207, 11208 and 11212.
- Bronx: The ASPCA Community Veterinary Clinic by Barbara Dauphin-Duthuit, located at 501 E. 161st St., Bronx, NY, 10451, is available to pet owners with proof of public assistance* living in one of the following zip codes – 10451, 10454, 10455, 10456 and 10459.

*To qualify for services, you must bring one of the following documentations to your appointment: Public Housing, Supplemental Security Income, Disability/SSD, Medicaid, Welfare, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Food Stamps, WIC, Food and Nutrition Services.

The ASPCA receives a high volume of calls each day. You may need to wait on hold for a while, but they will pick up. If they don't pick up, you'll have an option to leave your number for a callback and they will call you back!
