#### **What kind of cat qualifies as a “Working Cat”?**

ACC places cats who are not suited for typical indoor homes in environments where they will thrive and work with their humans to control rat and mice populations.

ACC is looking for adopters who seek natural rodent deterrents for enclosed properties such as barns, police stations, fire stations, warehouses, churches, garden stores, factories and other facilities.

#### **What kind of care do I have to give my Working Cats?**

Working Cats require adequate shelter and daily food and water.

All of our Working Cats have been spayed or neutered and have received vaccinations, however, they may need veterinary care in the future.

When moving to a new outdoor home they must be kept in an enclosed place like a crate for four to six weeks prior to release in order to acclimate to their new environment. If they will be in a secure building, they may be enclosed in a small room.

#### **Can I adopt just one Working Cat?**

Research has shown that Working Cats are happier and more successful and effective when placed in pairs or groups, so multiple-cat adoptions are encouraged, but not required.
